

# LT GOVERNOR ASSURES TO TAKE EARLY ACTION INTO THE GRIEVANCES OF SLUM DWELLERS

NEW DELHI, JUNE 29: The Lt Governor Mr Nazeeb Jung has assured inhabitants of slum-dwellers of Kathputali Ghar Colony, Opp Shadipur Depot that their grievances would be looked into by next week and all the slum-dwellers would be shifted to temporary transit camp so that the entire site be cleared for constructing pucca buildings here for them.

Governor also assured that he will discuss the issue with the DDA vice-chairman tomorrow in his office over how to vacate the site from slum-dwellers.

Around 500 residents of Kathputali Ghar, today went to meet the Governor over the issue which was lingering for the last two years. About 2 years back, the DDA had assured the residents of this slum to vacate this site to Transit camps so that the agency may able to construct pucca home at the same place for them but making dozens representations to the concerned authorities i.e. DDA, Lt Governor office and Delhi government but all went unheard.

It is to say, 2641 families are living in this slum for the last over 40-50 years, out of which 526 families were shifted to Transit camp Anand Parbat and still 2115 families are living in this slum hell.

Later in the day, a 15 members delegates, led by Islam Azad met the Delhi Lt Governor to listen their grievances and invited the suggestions how an early measures can be taken in solving this issue at the earliest.
